- Worship with St. Dysmas Prison Congregation \*\*NEW DAY AND TIME\*\* First Lutheran is taking a field trip on WEDNESDAY, November 1<sup>st</sup> to Sioux Falls to worship with the congregation of St. Dysmas. Because many of the men do not receive visitors this service is the only place they can enjoy conversation with someone who is not paid to be there or other inmates. Inmates *hear the gospel* from their Pastor but *experience the gospel* through outside visitors. Those who plan to attend must be 18 or older and complete a background check by October 8<sup>th</sup>. Attendees should be prepared to ascend and descend a flight of 30 steps leading up to the prison sanctuary. If you've completed the background check for St. Dysmas within a year of our fieldtrip date you do not need to do so again, but still need to sign up by the deadline.
