WORSHIP WITH ST. DYSMAS PRISON CONGREGATION- First Lutheran is taking a field trip on WEDNESDAY, May 8th to Sioux Falls to worship with the prison congregation of St. Dysmas. Because many of the men do not receive visitors this service is the only place they can enjoy conversation with someone who is not paid to be there or other inmates. Inmates hear the gospel from their Pastor but experience the gospel through outside visitors. Those who plan to attend must be 18 or older and complete a background check by April 14th. Attendees should be prepared to ascend and descend a flight of 30 steps leading up to the prison sanctuary. If you've completed the background check for St. Dysmas within a year of our field trip date you do not need to do so again, but still need to sign up for the visitors list by the deadline.
