

WEDDING FAQ

WHO MAY USE FIRST LUTHERAN CHURCH? First Lutheran Church is maintained and supported by its members to serve God in this community. Due to our busy church schedule, we are currently only able to provide wedding services for members. If you attend worship with us frequently and have yet to become a member, please contact one of our Pastors to find out when the next New Member Classes are held.

WHEN CAN I HAVE MY WEDDING? Weddings may be set for almost any time, except on Sunday mornings and on Saturday evenings. A worship service is held at First Lutheran on Saturday evenings at 5:30pm. A Saturday wedding time must be set for no later than 3:00pm and all items used in the wedding must be cleared from the church immediately following the ceremony as not to interfere with the worship service.

IS PRE-MARITAL COUNSELING AVAILABLE? Yes, it is an expectation for any couple wishing to be married by the clergy of First Lutheran. It consists of both individuals filling out a pre-marital survey. The survey is then processed and the pastor will meet with the couple to review the results. Plan on meeting with your Pastor for four, one hour sessions that can be scheduled to fit everyone's schedules.

HOW MANY WILL THE SANCTUARY/PRAYER GARDEN SEAT? The sanctuary will seat 400 comfortably and the prayer garden will seat 150 comfortably. Additional seating is available by use of folding chairs.

CAN I HAVE MY RECEPTION AT FIRST LUTHERAN CHURCH? Yes. Our fellowship hall is available for receptions and will seat 240 people comfortably. Receptions can not be held on Saturday evenings.

CAN I USE MY OWN PASTOR? You may have your Pastor assist one of First Lutheran's Pastors.

WHAT DOES THE CHURCH PROVIDE? The church provides only those facilities and furnishings that are already installed. All extra items shall be furnished by the wedding party. The church does NOT have wedding candelabra or a white aisle runner.

HOW MUCH WILL IT COST? The fees are listed on your Wedding Planning Form. A church pianist or vocalist can be hired, and that price will vary. It will be your responsibility to call and set up those people if you should want them to be a part of your ceremony. We will input that cost into your final wedding ceremony fees.

WHAT KIND OF MUSIC CAN I USE? All music used in the ceremony must have the approval of the Pastor. Instruments other than an organ and piano are permissible in the ceremony provided that their usage is in line with the worship service. All recorded music being used must be supplied to the church two weeks in advance, via a usb drive. All recorded songs must be in a mp3 format.

DO WE HAVE TO HAVE A REHEARSAL? Yes. A rehearsal gives the entire bridal party an opportunity to know just what is required of them in the service. It is also a good time for any music to be rehearsed as well. The Pastor will help the bridal party go through the service smoothly and with confidence.

WHAT IS NOT PERMITTED IN THE CHURCH? Members of the wedding party should be informed and inform other members of their respective families that there is NO SMOKING in the church. Alcoholic beverages are not allowed in the church or in the parking lot. Use of rice, bird seed, pew brackets, and red punch is not permissible.
