FIRST LUTHERAN DRIVE-IN RULES

as per the guidelines provided by the State of Iowa

- 1. ENTER ONLY THROUGH SOUTH DRIVE:** Please only enter the parking lot through the south, gravel drive. This will help coordinate parking as we will not have parking ushers.
- 2. FOLLOW THE PARKING MAP:** Please check facebook, your email & our website for a map of where to park. We will not have parking ushers for the foreseeable future. Having as many people as possible know where/how to park is important to ensure everyone can fit in the parking lot.
- 3. WINDOWS UP:** Windows should be rolled up for the entirety of the service. They can only be rolled down to drop offering in the buckets as you enter or exit the service.
- 4. BULLETIN:** We will not have any printed bulletins available. They are on our website. Please open them on your phones, tablets, etc. or print one at home before leaving home.
- 5. DO NOT LEAVE YOUR CARS:** No one is allowed to leave their vehicles before, during, or after the service.
