- 1. ENTRANCE:** Drive-In Worship is held on the North Side of Church. We will have two parking ushers to help coordinate and direct parking.
- 2. WINDOWS :** Windows may be rolled down for the service or you may tune in to 96.3FM if you'd rather not.
- 3. OFFERING :** Ushers will go around with buckets if you feel comfortable giving in person or you may give online at www.3cross.org or by mail: 1525 Three Cross Road, Milford, IA 51351
- 4. BULLETIN:** We will not have any printed bulletins available. They are on our website. Please open them on your phones, tablets, etc. or print one before leaving home.
- 5. DO NOT LEAVE YOUR CARS:** No one is allowed to leave their vehicles before, during, or after the service.
- 6. OTHER :** There will not be donuts, a porta- potty, or outside seating during the service.
