- **COATS FOR KIDS!!** You can help us help kids. In the front entrance of the church you will find a large box labeled, "Coats for Kids." We are hoping to fill this box many times over with new or clean, good used coats, hats and mittens for kids. Our first priority is to assist with any local needs that we have for ensuring kids are warm this winter. Beyond this, coats will be delivered to Des Moines for distribution there to elementary children, all of whom are from low income and/or immigrant families without appropriate winter gear. Jane Kruse will be delivering these weekly to Des Moines, as her daughter, who is a social worker there, has put out an urgent request for these coats, hats and mittens: sizes youth 6,8,10, 12, 14 and adult sizes, small, medium and large. Due to factors largely a result of pandemic conditions, the usual sources of their donations are depleted. Donations of Coats for Kids will be accepted immediately through Thanksgiving during open church office hours. Thank you for your compassion and for helping kids!

- 1. ENTRANCE:** Drive-In Worship is held on the South Side of Church. We will have two parking ushers to help coordinate and direct parking.
