This unique worship ministry began on May 22, 1949 at the Lakeland Drive-In Theatre that was located one mile north of Milford. This was considered to be the first outdoor worship service at a Drive-In Theatre in the United States! Today, we continue to provide this alternate worship experience for residents of the Lakes Area and those vacationina between Memorial Day and Labor Day.




FCN as Integrator of Faith and Health

Whether offering a listening ear, prayer support, or resources for healthier living, the FCN encourages a holistic approach to health that honors both body and spirit. Such activities might include:

- Supporting individuals as they navigate health concerns through the lens of faith
- Emotional support during times of stress
- Presence of self and active listening
- Spiritual support when needed
- Prayer/specific scripture for specific needs
- Decision-making support when requested
- Working with current church groups i.e. hospital visits, home visits, prayer chains
