***An Introduction To Our Lenten Drama Series***

**"IS IT I?"**

This year's Lenten drama series is shaped around the question the disciples ask when confronted with Jesus' news that one of them will betray him. One by one, they ask Jesus, "*Surely not me—Lord, is it I?*"

First Lutheran has an ongoing tradition of enacting this scene on Maundy Thursday in a performance entitled "**The Living Last Supper.**" This year, the performance will take place on Wednesday, April 1, and Maundy Thursday, April 2.

We wanted to take this question—one that drives toward confession—and place it at the heart of other people Jesus encounters on his way to the cross. Each character experiences both conviction by the Law and the comfort of the Gospel as they explore the question, "*Is it I?*" from many angles.

Our hope is that you might experience the same during these worship services as you ask Jesus Christ, "*Is it I?*"

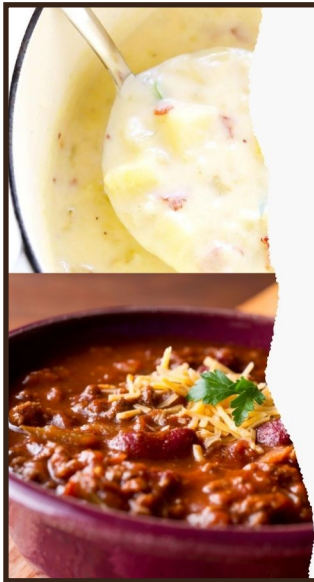
